

#### SCENE INTERVIEW

# **NADINE LABAKI**

talks upcoming *Capharnaüm*, the drama that earned her a 15-minute standing ovation at the Cannes Film Festval

#### What were the themes that you chose to address in Capharnaüm?

**NL:** I always feel the need to question the pre-established system and its contradictions through my films, even to imagine alternative systems. At the start of Capharnaüm, the themes were: illegal immigrants, mistreated children, immigrant workers, the notion of borders and their absurdity, the fact that we need a piece of paper to prove our existence, which could be invalid if necessary, racism, fear of the other, indifference to the Convention of Children's Rights.

#### You chose however to centre the film on the theme of childhood.

The idea of building the film around the question of mistreated childhood ... followed a heartrending moment that happened right around the time I was working on these ideas. Coming home from a party at around 1am, I stopped at a traffic light and saw, just below my window, a child half-asleep in the arms of his mother, who was sitting on the tarmac, begging. What hit me hardest was the fact that this two-year-old wasn't crying; he seemed to want nothing more than to sleep. The image of his eyes closing wouldn't leave me: when I got home I had to do something with it. I drew a child's face yelling into adult faces

as if blaming them for bringing him into a world that deprived him of all his rights. From there, the idea for Capharnaüm started to grow.

#### So what is the subject of your film?

Capharnaüm recounts the journey of 12-year-old Zain, who decides to sue his parents for having brought him into this world when they can't raise him properly, even if only to give him love.

#### What "lever for action" does Capharnaüm, and your cinema overall, represent?

I see cinema first as a means to question-and to question myself about-the current system, by presenting my point of view of the world in which I'm evolving. Even if

through my films, Capharnaüm in particular, I portray a disturbing and raw reality. I am profoundly idealistic in as much as I believe in the power of cinema. I'm convinced that films can, if not change things, at least help to open up a debate, or make people think.

#### This film marks a shift away from your previous work, where a certain optimism prevailed.

Zain succeeds in obtaining his documents by the end of the film. Rahil restablishes contact with her son... For the two of them, in real life as well, we've managed to legalise their situation in Lebanon. For once, I didn't want the happy ending to be confined to the screen and I hope it will happen in real life through the debate the film can open. Capharnaüm has allowed the actors an outlet, a space where they are allowed to cry out their suffering and be listened to. Just that is a victory.  $\leftarrow$










WOMAN WALKS AHEAD

Tn 1889, widow Catherine Weldon leaves behind her unsatisfying life in ⚠ New York City to pursue her dream to be a painter, and bravely travels alone to the Dakota Territory, with the goal of painting the infamous Sioux chief Sitting Bull. Despite his fearsome reputation, Catherine is surprised to discover that Sitting Bull is a more complex and intriguing man than she expected to find, and their relationship grows and deepens. But as the U.S. government plots to force the Plains Indians to abandon their land and move onto reservations, Catherine, Sitting Bull and the Plains Indians will be swept up in the dramatic and violent history that will end with the devastating battle at Wounded Knee. Says Chastain, "I wasn't familiar with Catherine Weldon and when I read the script I immediately started to research her because I didn't understand if it was a fictional character or if this was reality. And the more I read about her the more enthralled I was to play her and confused I was why she isn't mentioned in the history books."




#### **WELDON'S BRAVERY IS** UNIMAGINEABLE TODAY.

"What struck me," says Chastain, "is that in 1889, 30 years before women had the right to vote, by herself, she up and went to North Dakota to paint a portrait of Sitting Bull. The bravery and courage for a woman in that time to do that is shocking and inspiring. The government kept trying to send her back to New York, and she kept sneaking back."

Chastain is eager to bring more female role models to light. "It was very important for me to play Catherine Weldon-to bring her into the public consciousness, hopefully to plant a seed of inspiration in young girls. I think when you learn about women in history and the incredible things that they did, it inspires you to do incredible things."



"There was a great love between Sitting Bull and Catherine." says Chastain, "These two oppressed people that didn't have a voice when this nation was being formed, their love for each other and the companionship inspired hope. And I think that's a lesson that is important now, especially, but I think all throughout history."





#### How did you prepare for the role?

I've had the good fortune to meet several career diplomats in my life and it's always interesting to hear their take on situations. When people live in a country not their own they need to have tremendous respect for local culture and local politics to understand what's actually happening on the ground. That's pretty much what I tried to do with the character of Mason. He's a facilitator. He wants both sides to win. He's not there to undermine the other government at all. There's a great deal of respect and intelligence that goes along with that approach.

#### How was your experience working with Rosamund Pike?

Ros was quite wonderful to work with. She comes in as this mystery person in the second act, so it was interesting to forge the relationship between Mason and Sandy. He doesn't really know this person but he has to trust her. But how much? That dynamic dovetailed very nicely with the film's political nature and intrigue as we figure out where the story is leading and why.

#### What do you hope audiences will take away from the movie?

Everything's so polarised now that you can't say anything for fear of being a traitor to your party or a traitor to your country or a traitor to your religion. It seems like we only have the capacity to see things in black and white, but the world doesn't exist in that colour scheme. If we're not talking, we're fighting, and that doesn't seem to be a very legitimate way to move anything forward. So honestly, that's the message I hope people take away from this movie: Instead of fighting, maybe talking works a little better.

orting through a stack of offers after completing his Emmy award-winning run as Don Draper in the hit Mad Men TV series, Jon Hamm was pleased to find Beirut, a thoughtful thriller that offered a refreshing alternative to formulaic action blockbusters. In a suspenseful story penned by Tony Gilroy (The Bourne Identity), former US diplomat Mason Skiles is called back into service to save a former colleague from the group possibly responsible for his own family's death. We talk to the charismatic actor about his journey to Beirut.

#### What would you say attracted you to the project?

Big political themes don't get addressed very often in movies anymore. I was excited to make a movie that dealt with something important rather than just having the action element or a comic-book element, which seems to be the tenor of most large-scale movies right now.

#### What was your take on your character, Mason Skiles?

He's a communicator rather than just a terminator. He's not some guy who solves everything by throwing a magic hammer or casting a spell or doing things that don't really exist in life. As a negotiator, Mason's gift is that he's able to talk to people not in a backhanded or sneaky way but by basically saying, 'You have something I want and I have something you want. We have to find that place where we both leave something on the table and ideally, each of us gets a little of what we want.'

Brad Anderson's political thriller begins in 1972 when diplomat Mason Skiles' (Jon Hamm) world is tragically turned upside down. A few years later, the glamorous, cosmopolitan city will also take a tragic turn as simmering internal tensions erupt. When Skiles returns ten years later, he is greeted by a city ravaged by civil

We didn't want our Oliver throwing people off buildings, but he needed to be

DID YOU HIT IT OFF WITH CO-STAR BEATTIE EDMONDSON?

Most of my movies are for an older audience and so it's great to do a film that is kid-friendly, a project that my son can come and see with me. That will be a new experience. HOW WOULD YOU DESCRIBE YOUR CHARACTER, OLIVER? When we meet Oliver he is a very well-meaning vet but he is slightly naïve on his world outlook. You meet him as this athletic figure in the park and the next time you see him he is a vet. In every situation you see him he changes in the audience's estimations and therefore Sarah's. I haven't been in the dating game for a very long time. I often think about what it would be like if I went back in the dating game and I pretty much picture every date

Obviously it has this rom-com core running through it, and animal lovers will love it, but essentially it is a coming-of-age story with Sarah finding her feet, finding her place in this world.
